- ✓ **Strengthen and support the emergency food system** and home-delivered meals programs;
- ✓ **Remove barriers to health care**, such as transportation, costs, and lack of trust through culturally appropriate outreach;
- ✓ **Increase access to health care**, including mental healthcare;
- ✓ **Prioritize communities needing services**, such as home-bound seniors;
- ✓ **Increase access** for Latino, Black, Indigenous and other communities.

TOGETHER, we will:

- ✓ Provide wraparound services that **prevent homelessness** and keep people in housing;
- ✓ **Decrease housing insecurity** through rent/utility assistance, housing navigators, and eviction prevention;
- ✓ **Support the emergency individual and family shelters** that move households out of crisis;
- ✓ Take a region-wide approach to housing and homelessness services and **collaborate with regional leaders** to create a county-wide shelter system with a comprehensive and coordinated strategy for all types of housing needed, including stand-alone and scattered-site permanent supportive housing, engaging the private market, and **supporting the development of affordable housing**;
- ✓ **Reduce barriers** to housing for communities of color;
- ✓ **Change the perception** that homelessness is a public safety issue—it is a public health issue.

- ✓ **Build and strengthen** literacy;
- ✓ Work with schools and partners to **focus on reading proficiency**;
- ✓ Bridge the Digital Divide and **engage volunteers** to help students read at grade level;
- ✓ **Keep vulnerable students from drifting too far** away from achievement;
- ✓ **Increase access to socio-emotional support** services for teens;
- ✓ **Increase online learning** and socio-emotional supportive services for parents, caregivers, and teachers;
- ✓ **Increase access** to basic family needs.
