- ✓ Take a region-wide approach to housing and homelessness services and collaborate with regional leaders to create a county-wide shelter system with a comprehensive and coordinated strategy for all types of housing needed, including stand-alone and scattered-site permanent supportive housing, engaging the private market, and supporting the development of affordable housing:
- ✓ Reduce barriers to housing for communities of color;
- Change the perception that homelessness is a public safety issue—it is a public health issue.
