- 6. January 11th kicks off Letter Writing week. Participate by writing letters to isolated seniors. You can add some cheer someone's day.
- 7. Decorate reusable grocery bags and fill them with your favorite non-perishable food items. Feeding America offers a Food Bank locator, searchable by zip code, where you can safely drop off your donations.
- 8. Make "Peace Crafts" to celebrate unity and kindness. Place around your home or mail to family and loved ones.
- 9. Explore virtual exhibitions and learn more about the Smithsonian National Museum of African American History and Culture.
