ITEMS NEEDED:

- → Recycle-ready t-shirts
- → Scissors

- → Start by cutting 3-4" wide strips from the bottom of the t-shirt up to the collar.
- → Gather your t-shirt strips and tie off one end.
- → Divide your strips into thirds and braid them together. Tip: Try doubling up the strips for a thicker and stronger toy!
- → Once you've braided down to the end, tie off the end and cut any straggling t-shirt strips.
