### Give Your Children a Head Start on Financial Stability

### **CONVERSATION STARTERS - GET KIDS THINKING AND TALKING:**



#### What do you want to save for?

Could be to make a large purchase later – Try relating it to an item they want and could save for.



# Have you considered sharing your savings with others?

Could donate to programs that help other children such as Breakfast in the Classroom.



# Have you planned for emergencies?

Discuss unexpected expenses and how it is easier to handle when you have an emergency fund.

#### MAKE BUDGETING SIMPLE

- Find or make a bank(s) to separate monies
- Label them Spending, Saving, and Sharing
- When your child receives money, talk to them about how they could divide it, for example "spending, saving, sharing"
- Discuss programs that help children, such as Breakfast in the Classroom, that your child might want to donate to
