MAKE AN UPCYCLED TOY FOR OUR FURRY FRIENDS IN NEED

With a few old t-shirts and a "*paws*" in your day, you can make this quick and easy upcycled toy for a furry community friend.

HERE'S HOW:

Grab 2-3 t-shirts ready to recycle and some scissors to quickly fashion this t-shirt dog toy for the furry members of local families.

- Start by cutting little 2 – 3" wide slits from the bottom of the shirt toward the neck
- After you've cut your slits, just rip along the slit and your t-shirt will have the perfect strips of fabric for the next step.
- Gather your t-shirt strips and tie off one end.
- Divide your strips into thirds and braid them together.
- Once you've braided down to the end, tie it up to finish it off and cut any straggling t-shirt strips.
