The Situation In Maricopa County



1 in 4 children experiences hunger, unsure of where their next meal is coming from



- When children are hungry they cannot focus in class, putting them behind their classmates. This brings stress and anxiety into the classroom for the student, their peers, and the teacher, impacting the entire learning environment.
- Some children rely on school for all their meals and may not have access to nutritious food at home over the weekends.

The Solution: WeekEnd Hunger Backpacks

Thanks to our generous donors, kids have food over the weekend and come to school Monday ready to learn. WeekEnd Hunger Backpacks are a way for children in food insecure homes to discreetly receive meals for their family before leaving school for the weekend. After we fill plastic bags with the items needed, thanks to the help of our volunteers, we deliver these bags to local schools each Friday so they can be taken home in a child's backpack at the end of the day.
